3. The local Social Services Department can pay for your care:
You will first need to have a free care assessment carried out by Social Services to determine the level of care you are eligible for. After that Social Services will do a financial assessment to determine the eligibility and level of financial assistance required.

- Respite support: here the home help takes the place of the normal carer (who is normally a family member). This may mean staying overnight when a carer wants a holiday.
- Monetary help, a home help may be asked to collect a pension or pay a bill.
